Sir/Madam

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

1. It is pertinent to mention here that conditional permission to take admission with **100 seats (125 seats including EWS) of UG (BAMS) course and 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in 10 PG courses in the subject namely -(i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana -06 seats (08 seats Including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant -06 seats (including 07 seats) (iv) Rachna Sharir - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (vi) Swasthavritta -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vii) Rog Nidan - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (viii) Shalakya Tantra - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (ix) Shalaya Tantra - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (x) Agad Tantra-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23 was issued to you on the basis of undertaking submitted vide letter no.DAMS/NCISM/GAC/Deficineies-Undertaking/2022/AY-2/12714 dated 10.11.2022 by the Director of AYUSH, Government of Maharashtra and vide letter no. AYUSH/1122/C.R.115/Ayu-I dated 09.11.2022 by the Secretary, Medical Education and Drug Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai, in respect of fulfillment of all the shortcomings within stipulated time period in respect of deficiencies pointed out in respect of 1st appeal filed in the commission for issuance of conditional permission for academic year 2022-23.**
2. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Government Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, RajeRaghujNahgar, Sakkardara Square, Umrer Road-440024, Nagpur Maharashtra (Inst. Id- AYU0171)** inspection of your College was conducted on **15.05.2023 & 16.05.2023 on Hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and rating Board, NCISM to process **the Conditional Permission with**

100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in 10 PG courses in the subject namely –(i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana –06 seats (08 seats Including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant –06 seats (including 07 seats) (iv) Rachna Sharir – 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir – 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (vi) Swasthavritta -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vii) Rog Nidan – 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (viii) Shalaky Tantra – 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (ix) Shalaya Tantra – 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (x) Agad Tantra-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24.

3. Further, in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. On examining the case in light of above notified and approved criteria and on perusal of the visitation report, it was observed that the college was not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria due to following shortcomings: -

1. **Teaching Staff: -**

4. In view of above, the assessment report was placed in the **42nd Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **07.06.2023**. On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed therein as mentioned above the college was given an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of **even no. dated 07.07.2023** to appear on **12.07.2023** before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to **why not the conditional permission to your college with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in 10 PG courses in the subject namely –(i) Kayachikitsa - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana – 06 seats (08 seats Including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant –06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (iv) Rachna Sharir – 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir – 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (vi) Swasthavritta -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vii) Rog Nidan – 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (viii) Shalaky Tantra – 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (ix) Shalaya Tantra – 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (x) Agad Tantra-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020** be denied for the Academic Year 2023-24. The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof to substantiate the claims against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions **vide letter no. GACN/Est./Hearing/NCISM/MARB/3378-79/2023 dated 12.07.2023** against the deficiencies conveyed to them.
5. Whereas, the college through its representatives, **Dean, Dr. Subash Raut & Faculties & Dr. Gopal Sharma, Dr. Manish, Dr. Adarsh Desai** appeared before the Hearing Committee on **12.07.2023** and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college. The shortcomings communicated to the college, submission made by the representatives of the Ayurveda college and observations made by the Hearing Committee are as under: -

Ayurveda Samhita Siddhanta: -The Post of Assistant Professor (1HF) and the post of 1 Assistant Professor (Sanskrit) (1LF) does not exist on the establishment of government Ayurveda college, Nagpur. However, the proposal for creation of posts have been submitted to government of Maharashtra (attachment - I)	a) College submitted that there is no created post for higher faculty and for Sanskrit teacher in the department. Temporary arrangement is made for Sanskrit classes. Proposal for creation of post has been submitted to the government. Documents submitted. Principal also submitted that college has got 02 assistant professor in the department- i) Dr. Sonali- was present at the time of visitation but name not uploaded in part1. Committee verified the documents. Submission considered. ii) Dr. Ashwin- joined institution on 24.05.2023 as a regular faculty. Committee asked the college to submit the appointment order and joining report of Dr. Ashwin. Post hearing submission- College submitted transfer order of Dr. Ashwin Bhaurao Bagde, dated 23.05.2023. Committee observed that the said faculty was present at Gov. Ayurved College Osmanabad during visitation and was certified eligible by visitors.Submissionnot considered.Shortcoming of 01 higher faculty and 01 lower faculty persists. But department is fulfilling the teacher student ratio as Dr. Sonali has got more than 05 year of teaching experience.
b. There is a shortage of 01 HF - professor for PG in Kayachikitsa.	b. Kayachikitsa: - The Professor (1HF) Kayachikitsa was appointed on Dt.10.04.2023 through interviewDt.06.04.2023 vide appointment letter no. शाआमना /आस्था/ प्राध्या./कंत्राटी/नियुक्ती / १९३१-३६/२०२३, (copy attached), but in the view of complaint	b) College submitted that Dr. Sangita Jain was appointed as a professor on 10.04.2023 on contractual basis but she has been suspended based on a complaint and college has requested NCISM for verifying previous experience

c. There is a shortage of 01 HF for PG in Shalya Tantra.	c. Shalya Tantra: -In the department of Shalyatantra, apart from regular Professor the Dean is also having teacher code AYST00662 of Shalyatantra; Thus, there are two (2) Professor working at present. The advertisement for contractual recruitment for the post of Associate Professor (HF), Shalyatantra was published on date 01.11.2022. But no candidate appeared for the interview. The second advertisement for the post of Associate Professor was published on Dt.18.11.2022. But no candidate appeared for the interview. The third advertisement for the post of Associate Professor was published on Dt.01.04.2023. But no candidate appeared for the interview. The Process of recruitment of 2 posts of Associate Professor on contractual basis will be done in near future.	c) College has submitted that the department has got 02 Professors namely- Dr. Pradip Kumar & Dr. Subash Raut and 01 reader namely Dr. Neeta and 02 assistant professors. Hearing committee verified documents and submission considered. Department is fulfilling the teacher student ratio.
d. There is a shortage of 01 HF – professor for PG in Shalakya Tantra.	d. Shalakya Tantra: - The advertisement for contractual recruitment for the post of Professor and Associate Professor (HF), Shalakyantra was published on Dt. 01.11.2022 and the appointment order was issued to selected candidate. But the appointed candidate did not join the duties for the post of Associate Professor. The second advertisement for the post of Professor and Associate Professor was published on Dt.18.11.2022 and appointment order was issued to the candidates vide appointment order no. शाआमना /आस्था/ प्राध्या. / कंत्राटी/ नियुक्ती/६८६६-७० / २०२२, Dt. 24.12.2022. But candidates did not join the duties. The third advertisement for the post of Professor and Associate Professor was published on	d) College submitted that they conducted interview 03 times but selected candidates did not report. Documents submitted. College further submitted that necessary steps will be taken again for filling the vacant post. Shortcoming of Professor persists.

	Dt.01.04.2023. But no candidate appeared for the interview. The Process for contractual recruitment of 1 post of Professor and 1 post of Associate Professor will be done in near future. (Attachment III)	
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6. The observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", "The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2022 and relevant regulations thereunder, and once again as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the 49th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 27.07.2023.
7. In view of the observation of Hearing Committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report has been carefully examined in terms of concerned Regulation and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and board decided that the college is fulfilling the **basic eligibility criteria for issuance of conditional permission with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and in 08 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant -06 seats (including 07 seats) (iii) Rachna Sharir - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (iv) Kriya Sharir - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (v) Swasthavritta -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vi) Rog Nidan - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (vii) Shalaya Tantra - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (viii) Agad Tantra-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) and not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of permission in the dept of Kayachikitsa for 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) and Shalakyia Tantra for 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 for the Academic Session 2023-24 due to non availability of Professor , but Board decided to issue conditional permission as per the approved Seat Reduction Policy in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 for failing to maintain the minimum essential standards for the Academic year 2023-24.**

"In case of non availability of Professor in the Post graduate department or specialty permission shall be granted as per the teacher student ratio by reducing the intake strength in the concerned department".

As per sub regulation 1 of regulation 16 of (PG Ayurveda Education) Regulation 2016, The teacher-student ratio shall be such that the number of post-graduate teachers to the number of post-graduate students admitted per year is maintained as 1:3 in case of Professor and 1:2 in case of Reader or Associate Professor and as per sub regulation 2 of regulation 16 of (PG Ayurveda Education) Regulation 2016 The teacher student ratio shall be 1:1 in case of Lecturer or Assistant Professor having minimum of five yearsteaching experience.

In the department of Kayachikitsa, college is having 05 eligible faculty (01 Associate Professor for UG and 02 Assistant Professor for UG and 01 Assistant Professor for PG And 01 Associate Professor as excess staff) and there is shortcoming of 01 Professor in the Kayachikitsa for UG and 01 Professor in the Kayachikitsa for PG department, however 03 Assistant Professor is having more than 05 year of teaching experience, accordingly as per the available faculty, college is fulfilling the teacher student ratio as per the submitted seats in Part-1 and eligible for issuance of permission with 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) in the department of Kayachikitsa.

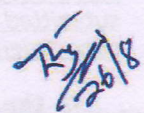
In the department of Shalakyia Tantra, college is having 02 eligible faculty (01 Associate Professor for UG and 01 Assistant Professor for UG) and there is shortcoming of 01 Professor in the Shalakyia Tantra for UG and 01 Professor & 01 Assistant professor in the Shalakyia Tantra PG department, accordingly as per the available faculty, college is not fulfilling the teacher student ratio as per the submitted seats in Part-1 and eligible for issuance of permission with 02 seats (Without EWS) instead of 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) in the department of Shalakyia Tantra.

Accordingly, after applying the seat reduction policy 2023-24 under section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 and as per the PG Regulation 2016, college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of **Conditional Permission with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and in 10 PG course with 56 seats (70 seats including EWS) [instead of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS)]** namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant -06 seats (including 07 seats) (iv) Rachna Sharir - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vi) Swasthavritta -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vii) Rog Nidan - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (viii) Shalakyia Tantra - **02 seats (Without EWS) instead of 06 seats (07 seats including EWS)** (ix) Shalaya Tantra - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (x) Agad Tantra - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder for the academic session 2023-24.

8. Therefore, in view of shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned as above and after applying the seat reduction policy 2023-24, Grant of conditional permission is issued to Government Ayurved College, Vazirabad, Nanded, Maharashtra-431601 (Inst. Id- AYU0185) for intake capacity with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and in 10 PG course with 56 seats (70 seats including EWS) [instead of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS)] namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant -06 seats (including 07 seats) (iv) Rachna Sharir - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vi) Swasthavritta -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vii) Rog Nidan - 06 seats (07 seats including

EWS) (viii) Shalakyata Tantra - 02 seats (Without EWS) instead of 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (ix) Shalaya Tantra - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (x) Agad Tantra - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic year 2023-24

- (i) It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 56 seats in 10 PG course (68 seats including EWS) [instead of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS)]** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
9. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
10. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
11. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
12. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023 **and send a compliance report to get permission for the academic session 2024-25:**
- (i) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
- (ii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;
- (iv) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
13. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.
