Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

- Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Government Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Raje Raghuji Nagar, Sakardara Square, Umrer Road-440024, Nagpur, Maharashtra (Inst. Id- AYU0171)** for intake capacity with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS), inspection of your College was conducted on 22.02.2024 & 23.02.2024 on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the conditional permission with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in 10 PG course -(i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (iv) Rachna Sharir - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (vi) Swasthavritta -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vii) Rog Nidan - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (viii) Shalakya Tantra - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (ix) Shalya Tantra - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (x) Agad Tantra-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2024-25, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.
- Further, in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. On examining the case in light of above notified and approved criteria and on perusal of the visitation report, it was observed that the college was not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria due to following shortcomings:-

3. In view of above, the assessment report was placed in the **95th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on **28.06.2024**. On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed therein as mentioned above the college was given an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of **even no. dated 08.07.2024** to appear on **10.07.2024** before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to **why not the conditional permission with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in 10 PG course (i) Kayachikitsa -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant -06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (iv) Rachna Sharir -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir -06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (vi) Swasthavritta -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vii) Rog Nidan -06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (viii) Shalakyia Tantra -06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (ix) Shalya Tantra -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (x) Agad Tantra -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2024-25, under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 be denied.**
4. The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions **vide ref. no.GACN/EsI./NCISM/Shortcoming/Hearing/3827 -28/2024 dated 09.07.2024** against the deficiencies conveyed to them. Whereas, the college through its representatives, **principal Dr. S. Y Raut, Dean** appeared before the Hearing Committee on **10.07.2024** and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college. The Post of Assistant Professor in Sanskrit is not also sanctioned and proposal is submitted for the creation of regular post till then the step-gap arrangement is made by according the permission to hire services for teaching of Sanskrit on lecture basis by Directorate of Ayush and two teachers are assigned the work of teaching in Sanskrit.(Attachment II)

- Recently for accommodating the additional candidate recruited by Maharashtra Public Service Commission and as per the Hon. High court Mumbai the existing post of lower faculty of kriya sharir is shifted to Rog Nidan The Process of re-assigning of the said post is under consideration by Govt. of Maharashtra.

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5. Thereafter, the observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations there under, and once again the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the **99th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 27.07.2024.**
6. In view of the observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report has been carefully examined in terms of concerned Regulation and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and Board Decided that the **college is not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for grant of conditional permission with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in 10 PG course (i) Kayachikitsa -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant -06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (iv) Rachna Sharir -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir -06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (vi) Swasthavritta -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vii) Rog Nidan -06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (viii) Shalakya Tantra -06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (ix) Shalya Tantra -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (x) Agad Tantra -06 seats (08 seats including EWS).** However, Board decided to issue conditional permission as per the approved Seat Reduction Policy in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 for failing to maintain the minimum essential standards for the Academic year 2024-25.

For UG course:-

- a) For every 10% deficiency in hospital staff seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by one seat.***

Accordingly as per the Hearing Committee observation and approval of Minutes in the 99th Board meeting of MARBISM, college is having only 69.6% of hospital staff. There is a shortcoming of 10.40% which is rounded off to 10%. **Therefore, in accordance of seat Reduction policy 2024-2025, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by one seat.**

- b) For every 1 % deficiency in Bed occupancy, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by one seat."***

Accordingly as per the Hearing Committee observation and approval of Minutes in the 99th Board meeting of MARBISM, college is having only 44.04% of bed occupancy. There is a shortcoming of 5.96% which is rounded off to 6%. **Therefore, in accordance of seat Reduction policy 2024-2025, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by six seats.**

For PG course:-

"In case of non availability of Professor in the Post graduate department or specialty permission shall be granted as per the teacher student ratio by reducing the intake strength in the concerned department".

As per sub regulation 1 of regulation 16 of (PG Ayurveda Education) Regulation 2016, The teacher-student ratio shall be such that the number of post-graduate teachers to the number of post-graduate students admitted per year is maintained as 1:3 in case of Professor and 1:2 in case of Reader or Associate Professor and as per sub regulation 2 of regulation 16 of (PG Ayurveda Education) Regulation

2016 The teacher student ratio shall be 1:1 in case of Lecturer or Assistant Professor having minimum of five years teaching experience.

In the department of Shalakya Tantra - College is having 02 eligible faculty (1 Professor & 01 Assistant Professor with more than five year experience; hence, eligible for guideship as per PG regulation 2016. As per the available faculty, college is not fulfilling the teacher student ratio as per the submitted seats in Part-1 and eligible for issuance of permission for only 04 seats (5 seats including EWS) instead of 06 seats (07 seats including EWS).

In the department of Agad Tantra - College is having 02 eligible faculty (01 Associate Professor and 01 Assistant Professor with more than five year experience; hence, eligible for guideship as per PG regulation 2016. As per the available faculty, college is not fulfilling the teacher student ratio as per the submitted seats in Part-1 and eligible for issuance of permission for only 03 seats (4 seats including EWS) instead of 06 seats (08 seats including EWS).

Accordingly, after applying the seat reduction policy 2024-25 under section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020, college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of **Conditional permission with 93 seats (116 seats including EWS) [instead of 100 seats (125 seats including EWS)]** in UG (BAMS) course and **55 seats (69 seats including EWS) [instead of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS)]** in 10 PG course namely (i) Kayachikitsa- 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana – 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant – 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (iv) Rachna Sharir – 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir – 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vi) Swasthavritta -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vii) Rog Nidan – 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (viii) **Shalakya Tantra – 04 seats (05 seats including EWS) [instead of 06 seats (07 seats including EWS)]** (ix) **Shalya Tantra – 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (x) Agad Tantra- 03 seats (04 seats including EWS) [instead of 06 seats (08 seats including EWS)]**, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic year 2024-25.

7. Therefore, in view of shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned as above and after applying Seat reduction Policy 2024-25, **Conditional Permission is issued to the Government Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Raje Raghuji Nagar, Sakardara Square, Ummer Road-440024, Nagpur Maharashtra (Inst. Id- AYU0171) with 93 seats (116 seats including EWS) [instead of 100 seats (125 seats including EWS)] in UG (BAMS) course and 55 seats (69 seats including EWS) [instead of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS)] in 10 PG course namely (i) Kayachikitsa- 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana – 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant – 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (iv) Rachna Sharir – 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir – 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vi) Swasthavritta -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vii) Rog Nidan – 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (viii) **Shalakya Tantra – 04 seats (05 seats including EWS) [instead of 06 seats (07 seats including EWS)]** (ix) **Shalya Tantra – 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (x) Agad Tantra- 03 seats (04 seats including EWS) [instead of 06 seats (08 seats including EWS)]**, for the academic year 2024-25, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.**
- (i) It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 93 seats (116 seats including EWS) [instead of 100 seats (125 seats including EWS)] and 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity in 55 seats (69 seats including EWS) [instead of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS)]** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
8. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
9. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
10. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
11. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2024 and send a compliance report to get permission for the academic session 2025-2026:**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.

- ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
- iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
- iv) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016;
- v) The shortcoming mentioned in Para no. 6.

12. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.

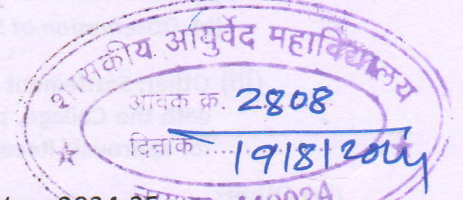

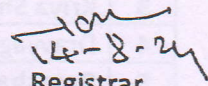
