Kind Attention: All candidates/institutes participating in PG-Counseling, 2023 are informed in respect of submission of following mandatory documents at the time of reporting at the allotted institute.

i. **Twelve months Compulsory Rotatory Internship Completion Certificate:**

Candidates who have not completed their **Twelve months Compulsory Rotatory Internship** at the time of admission/reporting for Round-1 and Round-2 of PG counseling are instructed to submit an Undertaking (**Annexure-I**), counter-signed by the Head of the Institution (the institution from where internship is being pursued). Further, such candidates must submit their original Compulsory Rotatory Internship Completion Certificate at the allotted institute **on or before the last date for reporting to the allotted institutes specified by the respective counseling authority for 2nd round of PG counseling.** Otherwise, his/her admission shall stand cancelled. The vacant seats thus arised shall be added to 3rd round counseling.

ii. **BAMS/BUMS/BHMS/BSMS Degree Certificate/Provisional Degree Certificate .**

If a candidate not able to produce a valid Provisional Degree Certificate due to non-completion of Internship at the time of admission/ reporting for Round-1 and Round-2 of PG counseling, in that case, the candidate shall submit an undertaking stating that **he/she will submit the valid Provisional Degree Certificate at the allotted institute on or before the commencement date of PG course (i.e. 01st December, 2023) for the academic session 2023-24** as already informed by NCISM/NCH.

iii. **Permanent Registration Certificate** issued by NCISM/ NCH/ CCIM/ CCH /State Ayurveda/Siddha/Unani/Homoeopathy Board:

Candidates who have not completed their **Twelve months Compulsory**

Rotatory Internship at the time of admission/ reporting for Round-1 and Round-2 of PG counseling, are instructed to submit a copy of the **Provisional Registration Certificate** at the time of reporting. Further, such candidates shall submit their original Permanent Registration Certificate **at the allotted institute on or before the commencement date of PG course (i.e 01st December, 2023)** for the academic session 2023-24 as already informed by NCISM/NCH.

iv. **Transfer Certificate/College Leaving Certificate:**

Candidates who have not completed their **Twelve months Compulsory Rotatory Internship** at the time of admission/ reporting for Round-1 and Round-2 of PG counseling, are instructed to submit an undertaking stating that **he/she will submit the Transfer Certificate/College Leaving Certificate on or before the last date for reporting to the allotted institutes as specified by the respective counseling authority for 2nd round of PG counseling at the allotted institute.**

Candidates who have appeared for AIAPGET - 2023 examination and desirous of applying for available seats of Ayurved/ Homoeopathy/ Unani Course in State Government/Private Aided/ Unaided Private and Minority Colleges situated in the State of Maharashtra, should Registered Online on website i.e. **www.mahacet.org**.

It is hereby notified that for admission to M.D./M.S. and PG Diploma Ayurved/ Homoeopathy/Unani Courses Online Application forms are invited from AIAPGET -2023 eligible candidates for **State Quota Seats**. The Candidates should carefully go through the Information Brochure before filling the **Online Application form**. Candidates are required to fill the Registration Form well in advance to avoid last minute rush. They should not wait till last date to fill the Registration Form. Any delay due to Electricity Failure, Internet Problem or due to any other Technical Fault will not be considered by the STATE CET CELL. The Information Brochure for admission to AYUSH institutions is made available on the website i.e. www.mahacet.org. Candidate should see the **Instructions/Notifications** published on the website for further Admission Process. **No separate or individual intimation is sent to any candidate at any time till the end of admission process.**

- There will be only 2 CAP rounds for All India Quota Seats in Private Unaided seats of Government aided Colleges and Private Unaided / Minority Ayurved/Homoeopathy/Unani Institutions. The seats remaining vacant after CAP-2(AIQ) will be surrendered to State Quota counselling.
- Choice filling process is one-time exercise and candidates should note the above and fill choices considering eventuality of such seats being added in seat matrix for MOP UP and subsequent rounds
- Candidates should note that the admission for IQ in Private unaided/Minority colleges will be done through CAP as per instruction of Central Council and desirous candidate should fill option for the same by selecting choice code with suffix 'N' in the preference form.

Instruction to Person with Disability Candidates (PWD) :

Those candidates who have marked/claimed as a PWD candidate in the Online Application, he/she has to Upload/Submit Original Certificate of Disability at the time of Registration as per the format published by Ayush Council Committee & State CET Cell website. The Certificate should be from the list of 16 Boards as mentioned. Certificate issued by any other Board/Civil surgeon **WILL NOT** be accepted.

Besides this all colored scanned copies of Original Necessary Documents like **Caste Certificate, Cast Validity Certificate, Non Creamy Layer Certificate, EWS Eligibility Certificate, PWD Certificate and Orphan Certificate** has to be Uploaded at the time of Registration Process.

Candidates belonging to **Backward Classes / EWS** must have claimed so in his online registration for Maharashtra State Quota, failing which such a claim will not be entertained subsequently. **Candidate belonging to above Categories should produce Caste Certificate, Caste Validity Certificate and Non-Creamy Layer Certificate / EWS eligibility certificate (wherever applicable) at the time of Physical Document Verification process & admission.**

The Physical Document Verification of Selected Candidates will be done to decide Eligibility or Non-Eligibility at the time of joining to respective college in the selection round(s). The Reserve category candidates who will fail to submit requisite documents as per respective category will not be allowed to join and will be considered as open category or changed reserved Category for further rounds. Such candidates will be considered for selection in subsequent round(s) on available seat as per merit and preferences filled by them, subject to full filling the eligibility criteria of Open Category/ Change reserved Category provided he/she fulfills the eligibility criteria of AIAPGET - 2023.

The candidate must have passed final year UG examination from a recognized University or Board or medical institution specified in the Schedules to the Act and enrolled in Central or State register of Indian System of Medicine and must have completed satisfactorily **One Year compulsory rotating internship as on or before 31.10.2023** (for academic year 2023-24 Only).
