

3. To report the ADR's and misleading advertisements of ASU&H Drugs to concerned IPVC at regular intervals.
4. To update and provide a regular status report of the programme as desired.
5. Other related activities assigned time to time.

General Terms and Conditions:-

1. Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery (B.A.M.S) Degree from a recognized Institute/ University under NCISM / NCH Act, 2020 or IMCC Act, 1970 / Hcc Act.1973.
2. Candidate should have enrolled in the State Register From ISM.
3. Good working knowledge of Computers such as MS Office, MS Word, Excel worksheet, Powerpoint.
4. Appointment will be of temporary and contractual nature for a maximum period of the duration of the scheme.
5. The appointment of the above post will be initially up to 30th September 2026 and may be continued for one year after receiving the direction from National Pharmacovigilance Center AIIA New Delhi. It may be extended further with mutual consent and based upon the satisfactory performance of the incumbent. The institution, however reserves the right of termination of services of the appointee forth with or before the expiry of stipulated period without assigning any reason.
6. In the circumstances of more number of applications scrutiny will be done and interview will be taken as per merit.
7. No TA/DA will be admissible for the attending interview.
8. Other service conditions will be as per the existing rules for contractual staff of the Department.
9. The personnel will have no claim for regular/permanent appointment under the Research Councils /Ministry of AYUSH or the grantee institution on completion of the period of appointment.
10. Dearness Allowance (DA) and City Compensatory Allowance (CCA) are not admissible under this scheme.
11. Staff will be eligible for 08 days Casual leave in a calendar year on a pro-rata basis and thereafter remuneration will be deducted on pro-rata basis.
